

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ESTABLISHING
JIM WELLS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Commissioners Court of Jim Wells County, Texas, will conduct a hearing on January 14, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the County Courtroom, 200 N. Almond, Alice, Texas, on the PETITION FOR AN EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT seeking to create JIM WELLS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT 2, in Precinct 4.

The District is to be created and to operate under Article III, Section 48-e of the Texas Constitution, as proposed by S.J.R. No. 27, Acts of the 70th Legislature, Regular Session, 1987, and adopted by the Voters at an election held November 3, 1987. The area of the District does not overlap with any existing Emergency Services District and generally includes the communities of Green Acres, Ben Bolt, Palito Blanco and surrounding areas. The boundaries of the District are more particularly described in the attached Exhibit "A" and also shown in the attached sketch marked as Exhibit "B".

Each person who has an interest in the creation of the JIM WELLS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 may attend the public hearing and present grounds for or against the creation of the District.

Boundary Description

Proposed Jim Wells County Emergency Services District No. 2

Boundaries are as follows:

1. North boundary will run east and west along Farm to market 1930 and Farm to market 625 from east county line to west county line. This will include all properties that are accessible on both the north and south sides of FM 1930 and FM 625. This distinction will make it easier for dispatch to know which department to dispatch for emergencies.
2. South boundary will run east to west along county road 433. This line will include all property that is accessible by way of CR 433, both the north and south sides of the county road. This distinction will make it easier for the dispatch to know which department to dispatch for emergencies.
3. West boundary will be county line.
4. East boundary will be county line.
