In presenting the Budget for 2026 to the Commissioner's Court and the taxpayers of Jim Wells County, Texas the following statistics are furnished:

The assessed valuation used in the compilation of this Budget is \$4,458,755,147. This valuation less exemptions shows a increase of \$305,345,175 from that of the preceding year and is based on 100% of the total market value of the property assessed.

The tax rate included \$ 0.702603 for operating funds, \$ 0.056039 for special road tax and \$ 0.009160 for debt service funds, a total of \$ 0.767802 on each \$ 100.00 valuation.

It is estimated that \$1,470,236 of the delinquent taxes will be collected during the year of 2026 which amount then added to estimated current tax collections of \$20,447,510 makes a total of \$21,917,746 estimated ad valorem tax revenue for 2025. It is also estimated that \$3,394,230 of sales taxes will be collected during the year of 2026.


When the 2026 budget is formally approved on September 26, 2025, the Commissioner's Court is hereby requested to approve the "Estimated 2025 figures as a formal budget amendment for the year 2025.

As shown by this budget, all county funds are estimated to be on a cash basis at the beginning of the next budget year.


Jim Wells County has outstanding bonded debt (Series 2023) but does not have warrants or registered script warrants.

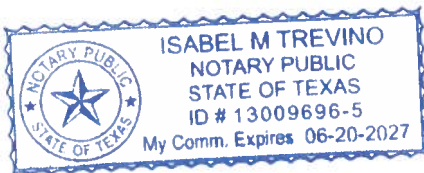

## ORDER TO SET TAX RATE

On this the 26th day of September 2025, the Commissioners Court of Jim Wells County, Texas convened in open session at its special meeting of said Court at the Courthouse in the City of Alice, Texas, with the following members present, to-wit:

And had the following Order passed:

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Jim Wells County, Texas, had considered the matter and deemed it appropriate to set the Jim Wells County Tax Rate at seven hundred sixty-seven thousand eight hundred & two millionths' cents (\$.767802) per hundred dollars valuation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commissioners Court of Jim Wells County, Texas:

That the tax rate for 2025 be set at seven hundred sixty-seven thousand eight hundred & two millionths' cents (\$.767802) per hundred dollars valuation, which is effectively a 5.81% increase in the tax rate. The tax revenue from same to be allocated on the following basis:

60.8506 cents (\$.608506) of said 76.7802 cents (\$.767802) to the County General Fund, (\$.599346) for Maintenance & Operations and (\$.009160) for Debt Service, 5.6572 cents (\$.056039) to the Special Road Fund for Maintenance & Operations and the remaining 1.03257 cents (\$.103257) of said .767802 cents per hundred dollars valuation to the Flood and Lateral Road Fund for Maintenance & Operations, for a total tax rate of seven hundred sixty-seven thousand eight hundred & two millionths cents per hundred dollar valuation.

### **THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.**
