



**ORDER RESCINDING PROHIBITION
OF OUTDOOR BURNING**


WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code provides that the Commissioners Court of a county, by order, may prohibit outdoor burning in the unincorporated area of the county if the Commissioners Court makes a finding that circumstances present in the unincorporated area create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and,


WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Jim Wells County Office of Emergency Management that the County Commissioners adopt and pass an order to rescind the current Burn Ban adopted on May 10, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Jim Wells County Commissioners Court concurs and does hereby find that circumstances present in the unincorporated areas of Jim Wells County no longer create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by certain outdoor burning; and,



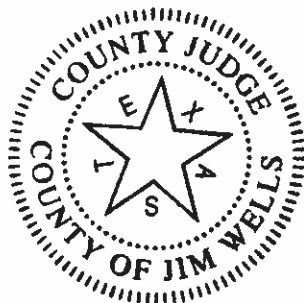
