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The following conditions must be met on the day of the burn

1. All TCEQ requirements must be met.
2. The weather on the day of the burn, as well as the forecasted weather for the next day must meet the following requirements:
 - The minimum relative humidity (Rh) must be above 30%. The Rh forecast for the day after the burn must be above 30%
 - The maximum wind speed allowed will be 20 miles per hour and the forecasted windspeed on the next day and day after the burn cannot exceed 20 mph. The minimum wind speed on the day of the burn must be 6 miles per hour.
 - The maximum air temperature at the start of the burn cannot exceed 85 degrees F.
3. Begin burning no earlier than one hour after sunrise, end it the same day an hour before sunset. Burning during temperature inversions or air stagnation advisories is prohibited. Burning is prohibited on any designated Red Flag Day.

4. All dozer piles must have a line down to mineral soil at least 8 feet wide and be located a distance of 3 times the height of the piles. If piles are more than 200 feet apart, lines must be constructed around individual piles. All pasture and woodland burning must have lines constructed around the burn unit. These lines must be a minimum of 8 feet wide, down to mineral soil and surround the burn unit.
5. During all burning, a mobile water system capable of holding and pumping a minimum of 100 gallons of water must be on site. If available, equipment such as tractor and disc, dozer or road grader may be used in place of a mobile water system.
6. No lighting or feeding of piles after 1:00 p.m. the exception will be lighting of prescribed burns of range land, agricultural fields, pastures, or woodland that are accompanied by a written and approved prescribed burn plan.
